As you saw published in the October edition of the Comment, on October 1, the COVID Committee and I met using Zoom to review materials which are available from the CDC, the UCC General Board and several denominations to explore how, and when, we can safely re-enter the church for our events.

We recognize how important this is to all of us and I can assure you that we will return to indoor services, soon. Meanwhile, as the building is nearly prepared for our return inside, the committee and I discussed the importance of receiving your input so that we can re-enter carefully, so enclosed is a brief survey seeking your input about your desire to meet inside and your expectation for us to do so safely.

The COVID Committee, the Board of Stewards and the Finance Committee will review your responses as we continue to discuss how we can keep the church building safe for you and your families.

Please note, even though we are not meeting inside the building, we are still meeting each week at 10am online using Zoom and we are meeting in-person in the parking lot at Church with our weekly Drive-In Worship Service.

Though it is getting colder, you are invited to bring a lawn chair and sit in front of your vehicle or in a designated seating area. We encourage everyone to wear a mask and observe safe distances between yourselves.

I hope that you are healthy and if you have not attended a service using Zoom or a Drive-In Service, I hope you will be able to come and see and experience the love that is shared as we worship together and hold fellowship, safely.
